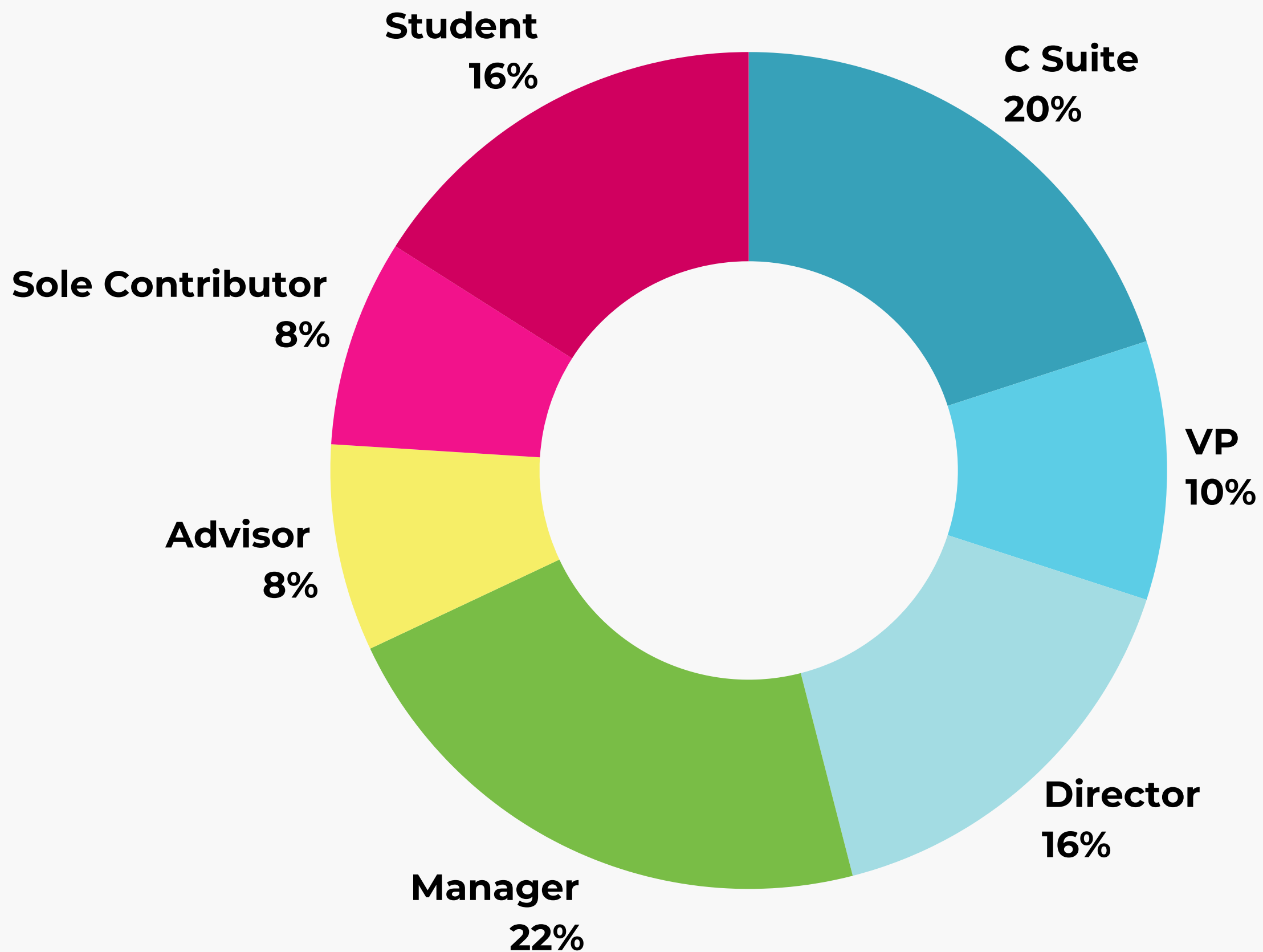
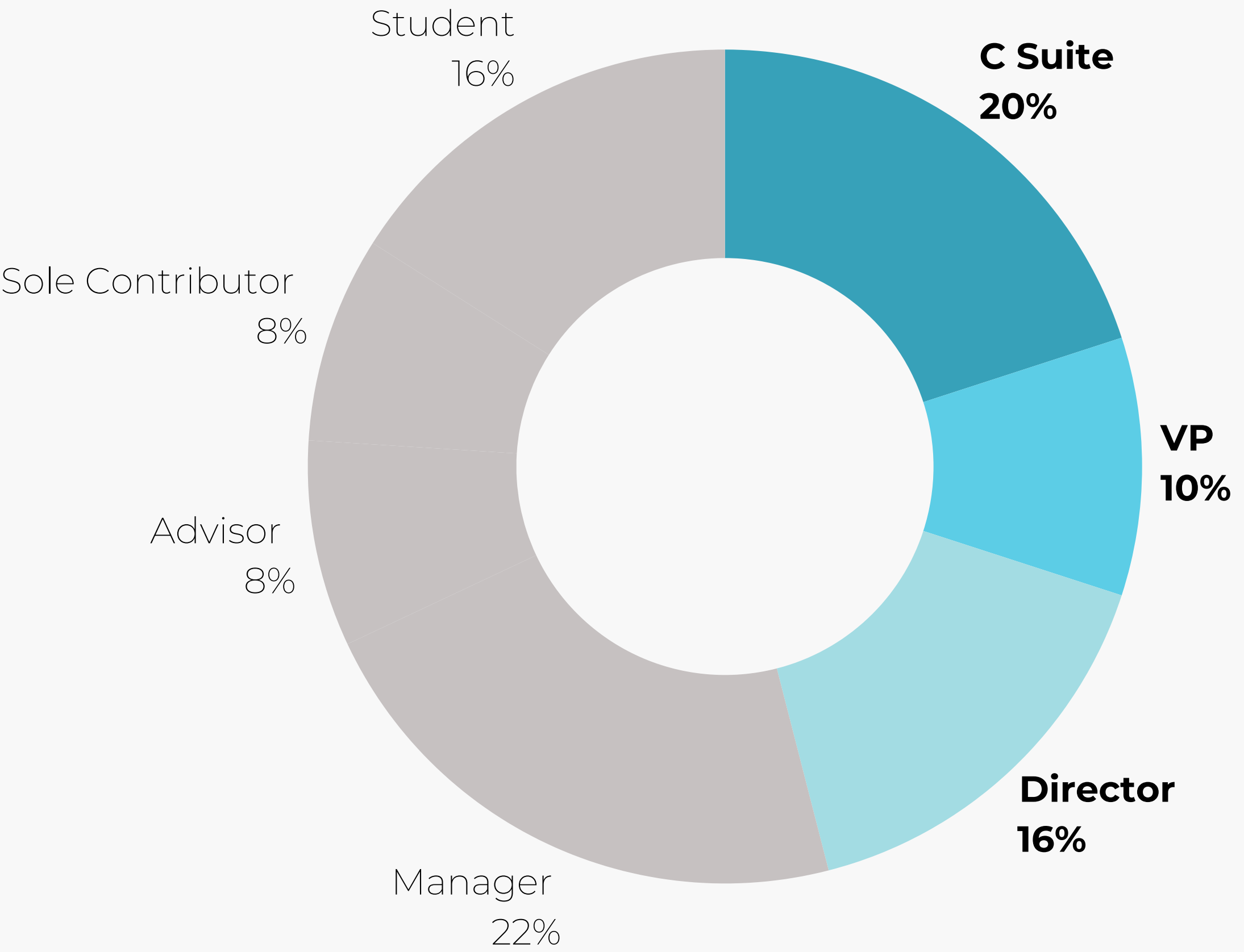

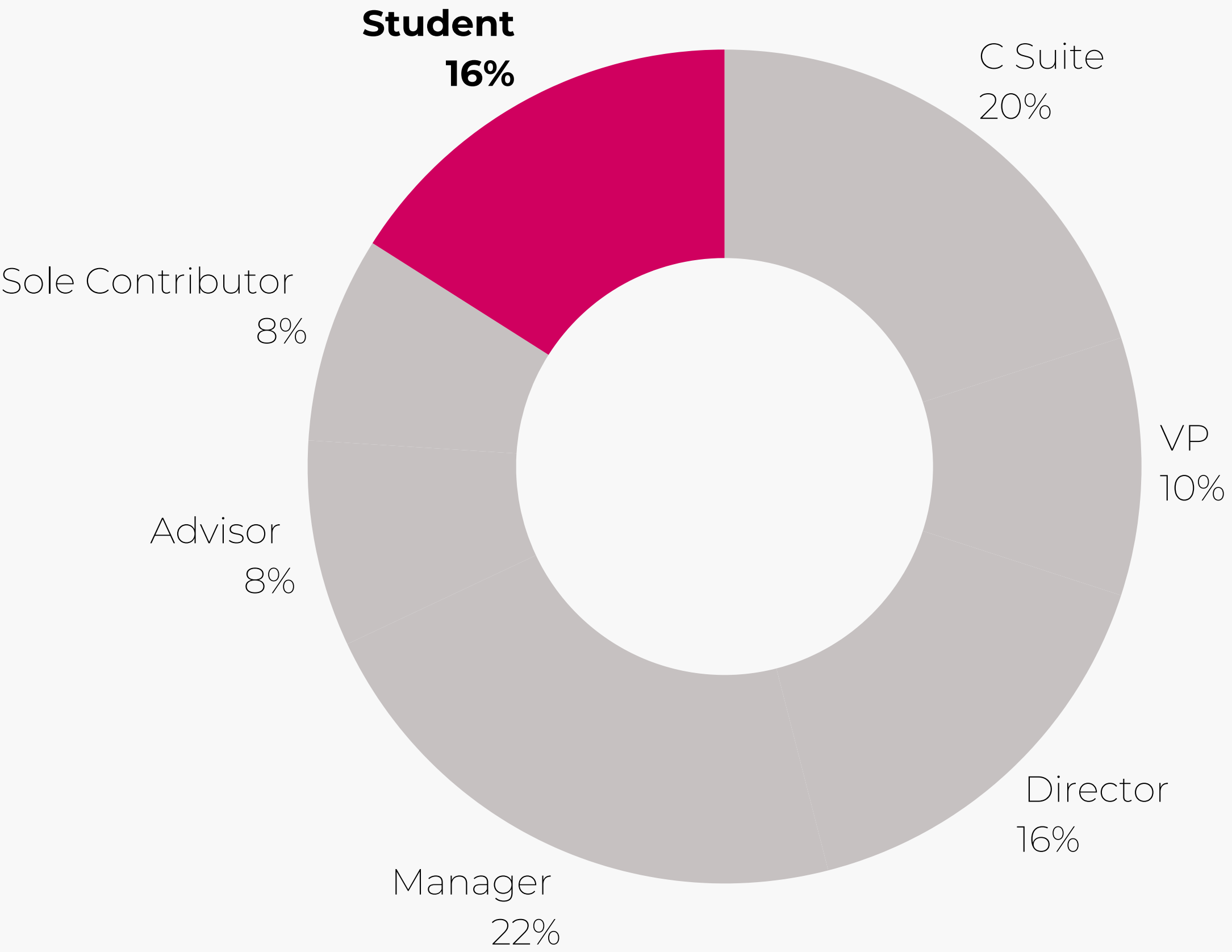

Nearly 50% of our delegates are individuals at a director level or higher. This includes a wide range of top executives, who bring a wealth of experience and decision-making power.

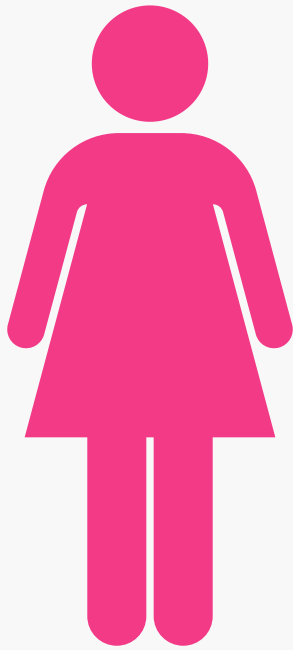
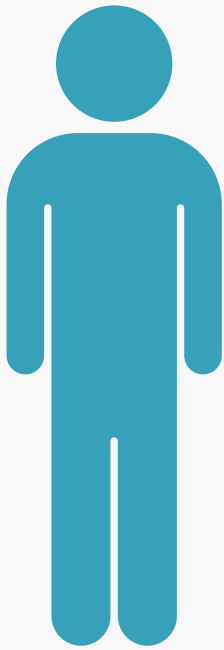
